## SERVICE ANIMAL - ADA - AMERICAN DISABIITIES ACT - No specific certification or registration



DISABLED PHYSCIALLY No food present



**Public Establishments** Restaurants, Stores, Hotels, etc.



Animal Typically a canine/dog Horses have also been used for mobility disorders



**BLIND OR DEAF** No food present



Tolerance Handles a variety of people experiences, evironments



**Emotional Support** Provides emotional support and comfort to many people



PTSD / PSYCHOLOGICAL DISORDER No food present



May live with disabled owners, even if "No Pets" policy in place.



**Function** Primary function to provide emotional support through Companionship



**MOBILITY DISORDER** No food present
